Winter Weather Reminder

Winter weather has settled in! Our Public Works Director, Logan Carpenter, works hard to clear the roads as early as possible to ensure public safety. If storms worsen, the Polk County Sheriff's Office may request that the City pause snow removal until conditions improve.

To help expedite snow removal, please ensure all vehicles are removed from the streets and avoid pushing snow from driveways onto roadways. Please note that no-parking routes are enforced annually from November 1 through April 1.

Holiday Light Recycling Program

The City of Alleman has partnered with Metro Waste Authority to offer convenient holiday light recycling for old or broken strands of lights.

Program Details:

- Collection Dates: November 10, 2025 – January 30, 2026
- Drop-Off Location: City Hall (during regular business hours)
- Please Note: No bags, please

All collected lights will be processed at the Metro Hazardous Waste Drop-Off in Bondurant before being sent to a specialty e-waste recycler.

Why recycle holiday lights?

The copper recovered from light strands is reused in electrical wiring, plumbing, construction, and renewable energy systems.

Recycling Reminders & New Options

Residents are reminded of the following recycling opportunities:

- 24/7 cardboard recycling dumpster located under the water tower
- Cardboard and glass recycling available at City Hall
- NEW: Battery recycling now available inside City Hall

With nearly all modern devices using batteries—such as cell phones, laptops, tablets, tools, and cameras—proper battery disposal is essential for safety. Battery drop-off at City Hall is free for residents.
