Old Business:

Ditching By Polk County is complete

28E Agreement from Polk County Sheriff

The Mayor and Clerk met with a member of the Sheriff's Department. Polk County would like to establish a 10 year agreement, with periodic reviews. We are waiting on their prices.

New Business:

A review of the Local Option One Cent Sales Tax was made by the Mayor.
Paying off the Berkadia Loan one year early (2020) was suggested and agreed upon.
The Mayor would also like to see cash reserve built up, which was also agreed upon by members of Council

Ric Long, Public Works Director gave prices for a new truck. 2020 F30 would run \$38,392.50 which would include the Snow Plow Package
A new plow would cost \$7,000.
